

## 1-Assistance for Defecation. An Enema bottle with a pump.

For the past 20 years, I have had constipation and difficulty defecating. I have used many brands of laxatives and various doses. Unfortunately, I never found a brand or a dosage rate that worked. The feces would be hard, and I would have to strain or runny like diarrhea. As a result, I had several disasters from bowel movements that I could not control.

To solve my defecation problems, I purchased a <u>Cleanstream Pump Action Enema Bottle with Nozzle</u> at Amazon for \$17.37. I no longer take Laxatives. I do not have to strain or have a runny stool I can't control. I no longer have any deification problems.

To lubricate the nozzle, I stick it in a jar of Vaseline. If I feel resistance an inch or two after the nozzle enters, I pump water, and the resistance will be gone. If it pumps hard, I move the nozzle in and out an inch or two as I pump. When the water gets to about 1/2-inch from the bottom of the bottle, I feel discomfort, which tells me it is time to pull out the nozzle. When I pull out the nozzle, water and feces shoot out in the toilet in one shot. There is no additional discharge. When I wipe, there is seldom any feces on the toilet paper.
